The Psalms 109 Prayer

Dear Lord, the wicked and the deceitful have opened their mouths against me. They have spoken against me with their lying tongue. My God whom I praise, please do not keep silent (Psalm 109:1-2). I ask that You appoint someone evil to oppose and accuse my enemies.

Let them be judged and pronounced guilty. Let their prayers forever be an abomination in Your sight. Let the prayers of my enemies and my accusers be a sin and condemn them (Psalm 109:6-7)

Mighty God, with words of hatred they have surrounded me, they have attacked me without a cause. Lord, You are a just God and You see that I am a man/woman of prayer (Psalm 109:3-5).

Let the days of their lives be few, and let another person take their job ((Psalm 109:6). God, cause Your righteous anger to be stirred up against them that their children become fatherless even to the fourth and tenth generation (Psalm 109:9).

Let their descendants be cut off, and let the memory of their names be wiped out of their family tree (Psalm 109:15). Let their names be blotted out of the book of the living (Psalms 109:8).

Let the iniquity of their fathers be remembered before You O Lord, and may the sin of his mother never be blotted out (Psalms 109:14).

Let their wives and husbands become widows. Let their children be wandering beggars, and let them be driven from their ruined homes (Psalms 109:10). Let their sins always remain before You, Lord (Psalm 109:15).

Lord, cause no one to extend kindness to them or take pity on their fatherless children for my enemies are evil and there is no kindness in them. Therefore, let the creditors seize all that they have, and let strangers plunder the fruits of his labour (Psalms 109:10-11). Father, they have repaid me with evil for good and hatred for my friendship (Psalm 109:5).

I have become an object of scorn to my accusers; when they see me, they shake their heads (Psalm 109:25). Let my accusers be clothed with disgrace and wrapped in shame like a cloak (Psalm 109:19). May that be the Lord's payment to my accusers, and those who speak evil of me (Psalm 109:20).

Father, they take no pleasure in blessing, for they love to pronounce curses. They wear cursing as a garment. Let those curses fall back on them sevenfold.

Let them enter into the bodies of my enemies like water and into their bones like oil. Let it be like a cloak wrapped about him and a belt tied around him forever (Psalm 109:17-19)

Sovereign Lord, help me for your name's sake. Deliver me out of the goodness of Your love. My God help and save me according to your unfailing love. Let my enemies know that it is your hand, that You, Lord, have done it (Psalm 109:26-27).

Father, let it be that while they curse me, You will bless me. Let those who attack me be put to shame, but let me as Your servant rejoice (Psalm 109:28). Lord, I extol and praise You for You are a defender of the poor and needy.

You save their lives from those who would condemn them in the name of Jesus (Psalm 109:30-31). Amen!
